Profile

Aziz Shuaib Ausi is an Educational Systems & Organizational Performance Specialist whose work bridges educational leadership, governance, institutional development and the responsible use of artificial intelligence in education. He approaches complex institutional challenges through systems thinking, viewing schools, colleges and education systems as interconnected organizations that improve when strategy, culture, operations and accountability are aligned.

His professional practice has been shaped by hands-on academic administration, leadership coordination and a sustained commitment to institutional improvement. At MEMA ASEP Learning Centre, he has served as Academic Master, Interim Head of the Islamic Department and a Member of the Director's Office, contributing to the structures, routines and decision-making processes that support teaching and learning. These roles reflect not only operational responsibility but also a developing leadership voice in how educational institutions can become more effective, accountable and sustainable.

His current professional work includes the development of the MEMA AI Governance, Management & Intelligence System (MEMA-AIGMIS), an AI-powered Institutional Governance, Management & Intelligence Platform designed to strengthen executive leadership, institutional governance, organizational performance, accountability, evidence-based decision-making and institutional intelligence in educational settings. The project is deliberately framed as a development effort - a practical inquiry into how technology can be designed and governed responsibly to serve educators and leaders rather than replace them.

Academic Journey

He completed his Ordinary Level Secondary Education between 2015 and 2018, undertaking it concurrently with formal Islamic Studies at Madrasat Taalimi wa Tarbiyah (MTT) - now known as MEMA ASEP Learning Centre - establishing the dual foundation of his academic education and Islamic scholarship. He then completed Advanced Secondary Education (A-Level) at Wali ul Asr Islamic Boys Secondary School, Kibaha (2019-2021), followed by a Bachelor of Arts with Education from the University of Dar es Salaam (DUCE) in 2024, with a Second Class Upper Division with Honours.

He is now undertaking a Master in Educational Management and Leadership (MEML) at Management & Science University (MSU), Malaysia (2026-2027), focused on the leadership, governance and systems dimensions of educational institutions.

Aziz served as Academic Master at MEMA ASEP Learning Centre from 2024 to 2025 and, in 2025, took on additional responsibilities as Interim Head of the Islamic Department and as a Member of the Director's Office. His practical experience also includes two teaching practice placements at Minaki High School (2022 and 2023).

Ultimately, the vision is for sustainable institutions: organisations whose excellence is reproducible across generations of leadership because it is built into systems, documented in practice and renewed through a steady culture of learning, accountability and continuous improvement.
